- To type a character in blue, hold down the Alt key on the right side of the keyboard and then type the appropriate key.
- To type an accented character, first press the accent key (two keys to the right of the L), then type the appropriate vowel.
- To type a “u” with a diaeresis (ü), hold down the shift key, press the accent key, then type the letter “u”.
- To type an “n” with a tilde (ñ), simply press the Ñ key (to the right of the L).
- Red keys indicate a second keystroke is necessary before a character will appear.
